Official notice is hereby given that sealed proposals will be received in the office of the Executive Director, Quad City International Airport, 2200 69<sup>th</sup> Ave, Moline IL 61265 until 2:00 p.m. local time on July 08, 2019, for the following:

### **RFP ON: ROOF MOUNTED AND CARPORT SOLAR SYSTEM**

SCOPE OF WORK INCLUDES: Qualified Providers are requested to propose the design, install, finance, commission, own, maintain and operate roof mounted and carport solar system. Qualified Providers to include two (2) options in the proposal:

Option A: Sale of energy generated to the Airport at per kWhr as Power Purchase Agreement (PPA)

Option B: Lease of the entire system.

Review of the proposals in response to this RFP shall be made in compliance 110 ILCS 805/5A-5 *et seq.* The Quad City International Airport (the "Airport") may enter into a contract with the Qualified Provider who best meets the needs of the Airport based on the criteria set forth in this RFP. The Airport reserves the right to reject any and all proposals or any part thereof, to waive any irregularities or informalities in the proposal submission and/or to award a contract in a manner best serving the interest of the Airport.

**Installation work under this contract shall comply with the Illinois Prevailing Wage Rate Act, 820 ILCS 130/0.01 *et. seq.***

**As a condition of the award of the contract for performance of work on the Project, the Prime Contractor and each of its Subcontractors shall be required to execute an Illowa Construction Labor and Management Council IMPACT Memorandum of Understanding.**
